The next Executive Director should be a strong and regular communicator of information to the Board and the member communities, possess demonstrated managerial and budgeting skills and the ability to make recommendations and implement changes as a need to ensure the optimum efficiency of the District's operations.

The ideal candidate will have a degree in Business Administration or Management or similar degree, experience in creating budgets and supervising staff, and five years of relevant experience or equivalent combination of education and experience that demonstrates likely success in the position.
